The *Special Needs Unit* is responsible for giving support throughout the university career to students with Specific Learning Disorders (SpLD)

✓ The service can be contacted via ticket



After the enrolment it is necessary to book a **taking charge interview** with our service by opening a ticket.

The meeting can take place in presence or in Virtual Classroom.

- ✓ During the meeting, the most suitable **compensatory measures** will be identified;
- You can consult the compensatory measures chosen on your **personal page** (Portale della Didattica, Segreteria Online, Special Needs);
- ✓ You can accept the measures validated by the USN by putting a flag on them;
- You will have to proceed with the signalation to the teaching staff, selecting the compensatory measures you intend to use for each exam;
- It is necessary to request the compensatory measures by October for the first semester, by
 March for the second;
- In addition to signal the compensatory measures on your personal page, you are invited to communicate directly to the professor, with a notice of not less than one week from the start of the exam session, to define the most suitable declination of the compensatory measures with reference to the specific type of exam;
- If the **formulary** is included among the compensatory measures, you must upload it into the *Computerized Reporting Procedure* to submitit to the professor and obtain its **validation** (well in advance of the exam date).

The Special Needs Unit is always available for an interview, at any time of the year, to help you **overcome any difficulties**, both in the management of the study and in the management of the exams.



- Students who are not in possession of a specific certificate of knowledge of the English language will have to take a level test immediately after enrolment;
- ✓ Also in this case students with SpLD can benefit from compensatory measures;
