WHO

Requirements for applicants with non-Italian educational qualification - to be confirmed for a.y.2024/25 -

Own a valid Bachelor degree obtained after at least 15 years of previous education (primary and secondary plus university)

meet curricular and quality requirements of the MS programme you want to apply for.

meet the language requirements

Non-Italian educational qualification - to be confirmed for a.y.2024/25 -

Bachelor degree or equivalent academic qualification awarded by an accredited foreign university obtained after at least 15 years of previous education

Students with “**equivalent academic qualification**” are those enrolled in a foreign university in 5 or 6-year - i.e. single cycle degree combined Bachelor and Master program - who have not graduated yet but meet the minimum requirement of 15 years of global schooling (minimum 3 years at University level) and have acquired at least 180 ECTS credits or equivalent

Curricula and quality requirements - to be confirmed for a.y.2024/25 -

An Academic Commission will verify the adequacy of personal preparation and consistency between the selected degree programs and the previous university career.

A specific document with the needed background for each course will be published in December 2023.

Language requirements

MASTER OF SCIENCE	MINIMUM REQUIREMENT
Programs in Italian or partially in Italian/English	English level B2 or higher + Italian level B1 or higher
Programs in English	English level B2 or higher

The complete list of accepted certificates + exemptions will be published in December 2023. The language certificate **MUST** be attached to the application before submitting it.

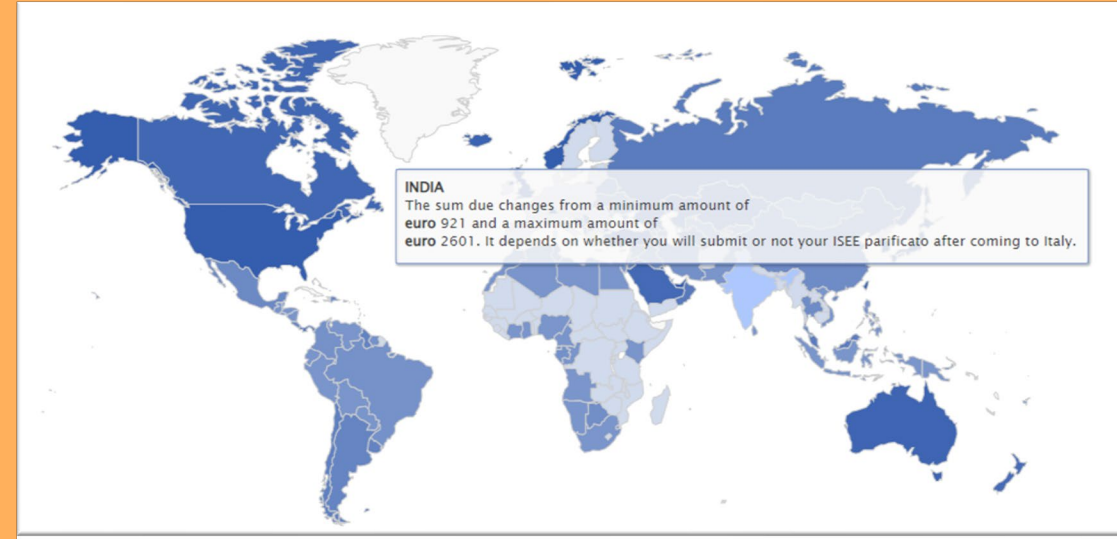


Visa release depends **ONLY** on the decision by Italian Embassy in your country
