- Visto il Decreto legislativo 14/03/2013, n. 33, recante "Riordino della disciplina riguardante gli obblighi di pubblicità, trasparenza e diffusione di informazioni da parte delle pubbliche amministrazioni";
- Considerata la Legge 6/11/2012, n. 190, recante "Disposizioni per la prevenzione e la repressione della corruzione e dell'illegalità nella pubblica amministrazione";
- Visto lo Statuto del Politecnico di Torino emanato con D.R. n. 418 del 29/11/2011;
- Tenuto conto che il Piano Strategico Orizzonte 2020 del Politecnico di Torino pone tra i propri obiettivi quello di incrementare il livello qualitativo dell'offerta formativa e di garantirne un profilo alto e internazionalmente riconosciuto;
- Considerato che nel perseguire tale obiettivo l'Ateneo si impegna ad attrarre studenti meritevoli da tutto il territorio nazionale e dal resto del mondo, valorizzandone il talento, anche attraverso una più attenta selezione mirata a facilitarne l'integrazione nei percorsi formativi limitando situazioni di disagio e difficoltà di inserimento;
- Visto che per rendere operativa questa azione nei confronti degli studenti internazionali, l'Ateneo ha avviato il progetto "TOPoliTO: attracting international Top students at the Politecnico di Torino" che intende rafforzare la promozione dell'Ateneo all'estero allo scopo di orientare e selezionare i giovani che chiedono di iscriversi al nostro Ateneo;
- Tenuto conto che una delle linee di azione (linea 2) in cui si articola il suddetto Progetto prevede l'orientamento, la selezione e la valorizzazione degli studenti internazionali, con individuazione delle aree geografiche di maggiore interesse (Asia e Sud-Est Asiatico, America Latina, Nord Africa e medio Oriente) e l'attivazione di test in sede;
- Visto che il Consiglio di Amministrazione nella seduta del 19 dicembre 2016 ha stanziato una somma pari a € 4.500.000 finalizzata a supportare la linea di azione su descritta con borse di studio da destinare ai migliori studenti selezionati e altri strumenti di promozione;
- Visto il Bando di selezione per l'ammissione ai corsi di laurea dell'area dell'Ingegneria, emanato con D.R. n. 121 del 12 febbraio 2018; il Bando di selezione per l'ammissione ai corsi di laurea in Design e Comunicazione Visiva, emanato con D.R. n. 122 del 12 febbraio 2018; il Bando di selezione per l'ammissione ai corsi di laurea in Pianificazione territoriale, urbanistica e paesaggistico-ambientale, emanato con D.R. n. 123 del 12 febbraio 2018;
- Tenuto conto delle indicazioni dei criteri individuati dalla Commissione Mobilità Internazionale per l'assegnazione delle borse di studio TOPoliTO ovvero che:
 - le suddette borse di studio siano assegnate ai migliori studenti provenienti da scuole superiori con sede estera iscritti per la prima volta a un Corso di Laurea di I livello del Politecnico valutati sulla base del risultato del test di ammissione;
 - possano ottenere il requisito di idoneità alla borsa di studio gli studenti che ottengono un punteggio pari o superiore a 60/100 al test di ammissione;



- l'importo di ciascuna borsa sia pari a 8.000 euro/anno (costo ente) per tre anni (fatta salva la verifica del mantenimento dei livelli di merito);

DETERMINA

**TOPoliTO Scholarships - Bachelor of Science programs
Call for applications for the 2018/19 academic year
for international students sitting for the admission test in Italy**

Introduction

Politecnico di Torino has launched the program “*TOPoliTO: attracting top students at the Politecnico di Torino*” aimed at strengthening the University's ability to attract talented international students, who will have access to undergraduate and graduate degree courses offered by Politecnico di Torino.

Within this program, Politecnico di Torino offers to international students¹ who:

- **meet the application requirements** in the **art. 2 below**
- **will enroll** at Politecnico di Torino in the **2018/19 academic year** -for the first time- in a **Bachelor of Science program** in *Engineering/ Design and Visual Communication/ Territorial, Urban, Environmental and Landscape Planning/ Architecture*

the opportunity to be awarded a scholarship to complete the program they are enrolled in.

1. Scholarships

The project will award **39** scholarships for international students at the Bachelor of Science level sitting for admission test sessions² in Italy as follows:

- **24** scholarships for *Engineering*
- **3** scholarships for *Design and Visual Communication*
- **2** scholarships for *Territorial, Urban, Environmental and Landscape Planning*
- **10** scholarships for *Architecture*

The Gross Amount of the scholarship is 8.000 € per year for the whole duration of the degree program (3 years). The amount gross of all charges for the beneficiary account is 7.373,27 € per year³.

2. Application requirements and incompatibility

Application is open to international students who, **in spite of the citizenship**, meet the following requirements:

- having a Secondary High School Diploma obtained outside Italy

or

- attending the last year of secondary high school located outside Italy³

or

- attending a study program in a foreign university outside Italy⁴, when necessary to fulfill the minimum entry requirements to access the Italian university (for further details http://international.polito.it/admission/prospective_students/admission_to_bachelor_of_science_programs)
- fulfilling the access requirements according to the Call for admission to Bachelor Degree Programs for a.y. 2018/19 (for details http://orienta.polito.it/bandi_di_selezione_18_19)
- not having been enrolled, before the 2018/19 academic year, in any First, Second or Third Cycle degree program in an Italian university
- not being the recipient of any other Italian or foreign scholarships (including scholarships of the Regional Agency for the Right to Education of Piedmont --EDISU)
- not being part of a Double Degree program as an incoming student.

3. How to apply

Application for TOPoliTO scholarships for admission test in Italy must be submitted from **the date of publication of this call** within **14/09/2018**.

Students interested in applying for TOPoliTO Scholarships have to:

- fill-in the on-line application form APPLY@POLITO, submit it and register to the admission test to be held in Italy;
- flag the option "*I wish to apply to TOPoliTO scholarships to enroll to Bachelor of Science programs in the A.Y. 2018/19*" under the "Research and Academic scholarships" section of APPLY@POLITO.

4. Assignment requirements and procedures

Students eligible for assignment of the scholarship must:

1. pass the admission test with the best score, provided that the score is at least **60**;
2. not being the recipient of any other Italian or foreign scholarships (including scholarships of the Regional Agency for the Right to Education of Piedmont –EDISU) at the moment of the assignment nor for the entire duration of the TOPoliTO scholarship (a.y. 2018/19 - a.y. 2019/20 – a.y. 2020/21)

Students in possession of international certification exempting from the admission test are required to sit for admission test if they intend to apply for the assignment of the scholarships.

At the end of the selection process, a separate list of standings with winners/eligible/not eligible applicants for each program (*Engineering/ Design and Visual Communication/ Territorial, Urban, Environmental and Landscape Planning/ Architecture*) will be published.

The list of standings will be drawn up in decreasing order. Assignments will be based on the number of scholarships available for each program. In case two or more candidates obtain the same score, the younger will be awarded the scholarship.

The lists of standings will be published on the online [Official Register of the Politecnico di Torino](#) and on the [TOPoliTO project website](#).

Publication of the lists of standings is foreseen as follows:

- Admission test for *Engineering/ Design and Visual Communication/ Territorial, Urban, Environmental and Landscape Planning* :
 - 26/09/2018: publication of 1st provisional list of standings
 - 03/10/2018: publication of final list of standings
 - 10/10/2018: deadline for the acceptance of the scholarships by the winner students
 - 24/10/2018: publication of update final list of standings upon reassignment in case of withdrawal of winners
- Admission test for *Architecture*: the final dates will be finalized after the publication of the national notice of competition for Architecture admission test and published on the project website http://international.polito.it/financial_aid/topolito_scholarships.

The publication of the standings on the online Official Register of the Politecnico di Torino and on the TOPoliTO project website will be, for all intents and purposes, the only official notification of inclusion in the lists of selections and, for students with the appropriate qualifications, the only official communication that they have been awarded a scholarship. We emphasize that the Politecnico di Torino assumes no responsibility for the applicant's failure to view the standings and/or the terms for the acceptance of the scholarships as published on the online Official Register of the Politecnico.

5. Acceptance

An e-mail message will be sent to winner applicants who, based on the number of scholarships available, could be assigned the scholarship. This e-mail will summarize the terms for the acceptance of the scholarship. Nevertheless, this message does not constitute an official communication of the outcome of the selection.

In order to confirm the position in the ranking, winners students will have to officially accept it, under penalty of loss of the scholarship. Acceptance will be expressed by filling-in the acceptance form attached to the mentioned e-mail within the deadlines indicated in art. 4.



By filling-in the form, winner students will state their full acceptance of the scholarship, at the conditions laid down in the call for applications, and declare, under their own full responsibility, that they do not fall within any of the conditions of incompatibility laid down in art. 2 of this call for applications. They shall also commit to notify the university of any variation in the declared information which may arise during the academic year.

6. Payment and requirements to maintain the scholarship

Payment of the scholarship is subordinate to:

- the possession of the application requirements listed in art. 2;
- the effective admission and enrollment in a Bachelor of Science program among *Engineering/ Design and Visual Communication/ Territorial, Urban, Environmental and Landscape Planning/ Architecture*;
- the possession of the relevant documentation for enrollment for 2018/19 a. y. according to the Call for admission to Bachelor Degree Programs for a.y. 2018/19 (http://orienta.polito.it/it/bandi_di_selezione_18_19). **In case of “provisional enrollment”, scholarships will be paid only after the submission of the required documentation by the student;**
- the possession of the maintenance requirements explained below in this article.

Payment of the scholarship will occur in monthly installments. Payment procedures are expected to start not later than December 2018.

In order to receive the payment, scholarship recipients will be required to open a bank account in their name in Italy.

Payment of the scholarship will be suspended:

- 1) if the academic performance of the recipient does not meet a satisfactory level; in particular, in order to maintain the scholarship, recipients must achieve a minimum of:
 - 40 credits (CFU) within the exam session of September 2019
 - 90 credits (CFU) within the exam session of September 2020
- 2) if the student obtains any other Italian or foreign scholarships (including scholarships of the Regional Agency for the Right to Education of Piedmont –EDISU)

Please note that: extra curricula or recognized credits (i.e. exams passed in a previous university career) are not considered in the minimum number of achieved credits.

The amount of the scholarship will not be increased in case the student needs more time to graduate than indicated.



7. Other important information

Credit recognition: scholarship recipients enrolled in a Bachelor of Science program can accept a **maximum of 30 recognized credits** to maintain the scholarship.

Outgoing mobility: TOPoliTO scholarship recipients can apply to outbound activities in the frame of the mobility calls. Nevertheless, due to the impossibility to be the recipients of other scholarships, the only financial support for the outgoing mobility will be TOPoliTO scholarship.

Costs not covered by the scholarship: TOPoliTO Scholarships do not include tuition fees, travel and accommodation costs, which are thus totally at the expense of the student.

Tuition fees: TOPoliTO scholarship recipients can apply for tuition fees reduction. For more information see https://didattica.polito.it/tasse_riduzioni/index_en.html
