- Tenuto conto che la scadenza per partecipare al Bando suddetto è il 9/10/2017 e che uno dei requisiti per essere ammessi a concorrere all'attribuzione delle borse è il superamento di almeno 40 CFU entro il 23/09/2017;
- Tenuto conto dello sciopero dei docenti universitari, proclamato il 27 giugno 2017, che prevede l'astensione dagli esami di profitto nella sessione autunnale a.a. 2016/17 e che, in base a tale sciopero, verranno predisposti, in caso di astensione del docente, appelli straordinari a partire da 14 giorni dalla data del giorno di astensione dall'esame;

TOPoliTO Scholarships – Master of Science programs

Call for applications for international students enrolled in the 2016/17 academic year

Introduction

The Politecnico di Torino has launched the program “*TOPoliTO: attracting top students at the Politecnico di Torino*” aimed at strengthening the University's ability to attract talented international students to undergraduate and graduate degree courses offered by Politecnico di Torino.

Within this program, Politecnico di Torino offers international¹ students who **meet the application requirements in art. 2 below** and who are enrolled in **2016/17 academic year** in a **Master of Science program** of Politecnico di Torino, in *Engineering* or *Architecture fields*, the opportunity to be awarded a **scholarship** to complete the programme they are enrolled in.

The initiative is promoted by the Politecnico di Torino with the support of Compagnia di San Paolo.

1. Amount and duration of the Scholarships

The project will award **12** scholarships to international students enrolled in the 2016/17 academic year at the **Master of Science level** as follows:

- **10** scholarships to students enrolled in *Engineering* field programs² for a.y. 2016/17 and 2017/18
- **2** scholarships to students enrolled in *Architecture* field programs³ for a.y. 2016/17 and 2017/18

The Gross Amount of the scholarship will be 8.000 € per year for the 2 years of the program. The amount gross of all charges for the beneficiary account is 7.373,27 € per year.⁴

2. Application requirements and incompatibility

Application is open to international students who, **in spite of the citizenship**, meet the following requirements:

- having a Bachelor Degree obtained in an University outside Italy or, in case of 5 or 6 years degree programs, having 180 CFU equivalent
- not having been enrolled, before the 2016/17 academic year, in any First, Second, Third Cycle Degree programme or Specializing Master in an Italian university, with the exception of students in the frame of Double or Joint Degree projects who have obtained a Laurea degree (First Cycle) of Politecnico di Torino or any other Italian University and a First Cycle Degree at their home institution
- ~~having achieved at least 40 credits within 23/09/2017 (excluding recognized credits and language exams not passed at Politecnico di Torino)~~
- not having obtained a credit recognition higher than 20 credits
- having registered for 2017/18 a.y. in the second year of the same Master of Science program of first enrollment within October 9th, 2017 (according to the 2017/18 Student Guide)
- not being the recipient of any other Italian or foreign scholarships (including scholarships of the Regional Agency for the Right to Education of Piedmont -EDISU)
- not being part of a Double or Joint Degree project as an incoming student attending a Master of Science programme.

3. Assignment requirements

Applicants will be selected based on the marks and number of credits achieved and registered by 23/9/2017 by the Autumn examination session. Only students having obtained at least 40 credits (excluding recognized credits and language exams not passed at Politecnico di Torino) will be considered for the ranking list.

4. Assignment procedure

The list of standings of students matching all requirements indicated at article 2 will be established by multiplying the number of credits of each exam achieved and registered by the Autumn examination session 23/9/2017 for the mark obtained. The sum of the results obtained will then be divided for the number of semesters from the enrollment.

The list of standings will be drawn up in decreasing order based on the results thus obtained. Assignments will be based on the number of scholarships available and separate list of standings with eligible applicants for *Engineering* and *Architecture* field will be published.

In case the scholarships available for a specific field (*Engineering* or *Architecture*) are not all awarded, the remaining scholarships will be transferred and made available to eligible students of the other field according to the list of standings.

In case two or more candidates obtain the same score, the younger will be awarded the scholarship.



Publication of the final lists of standings is foreseen after the Autumn examination session. Dates of publication and deadlines for acceptance will be communicated on the TOPoliTO project website http://international.polito.it/financial_aid/topolito_scholarships/2016_2017/master_of_science, as follows:

- publication of 1st list of standing: **24/10/2017**
- deadline for the acceptance of the scholarships by the students: **31/10/2017**
- publication of 2nd list of standing (in case of withdraw⁵ of eligible students): **7/11/2017**
- deadline for the acceptance of the scholarships by the students: **13/11/2017**

The lists of standings will be published to the online Official Register of the Politecnico di Torino (https://www.swas.polito.it/dotnet/albo_online/) and on the TOPoliTO project website http://international.polito.it/financial_aid/topolito_scholarships/2016_2017/master_of_science.

The affixing of the standings to the online Official Register of the Politecnico di Torino and on the TOPoliTO project website will be, for all intents and purposes, the only official notification of inclusion in the lists of selections and, for students with the appropriate qualifications, the only official communication that they have been awarded a scholarship. We emphasize that the Politecnico di Torino assumes no responsibility for the applicant's failure to view the standings and/or the terms for the acceptance of the scholarships as published on the online Official Register of the Politecnico.

5. How to apply

Students interested in applying for TOPoliTO Master of Science Scholarships have to submit the application **from the date of publication of this call within 9/10/2017 20/10/2017** through the online procedure which can be accessed through the "Portale della Didattica" - Section "La mia didattica".

6. Acceptance

An e-mail message will be sent to eligible applicants that, based on the number of scholarships available, could be assigned the scholarship. This e-mail will summarize the terms for the acceptance of the scholarship. Nevertheless, this message does not constitute an official communication of the outcome of the selection.

In order to confirm the position in the ranking, eligible students will have to officially accept it, under penalty of loss of the scholarship. Acceptance will be expressed according to the procedures indicated in the mentioned e-mail within the deadlines indicated in art. 4.

By accepting the scholarship, eligible students will state their full acceptance of the conditions laid down in the call for applications, and declare, under their own full responsibility, that they do not fall within any of the

conditions of incompatibility laid down in art. 2 of this call for applications. They shall also commit to notify the university of any variation in the declared information which may arise during the year.

7. Payment and requirements to maintain the scholarship

Payment for 2016/17 a.y. will be done with a single installment. Payment for 2017/18 a.y. will occur monthly.

In order to receive the payment, scholarship recipients will be required to open a bank account in their name in an Italian bank.

In order to maintain the scholarship for a.y. 2017/18, recipients must:

- be registered for a.y. 2017/18 in the second year of the same Master of Science course of first enrollment (internal transfer to another course is not compatible with the maintenance of the scholarship)
- have achieved a minimum of 12 credits within March 3rd, 2018. In case this requirement is not met within the mention date, the payment of the scholarships will be stopped. Scholarship payment can be restarted only if the 12 credits are obtained within July 28th, 2018.

The amount of the scholarship will not be increased in case the student needs more time to graduate than indicated.

8. Notes

Scholarships do not include tuition fees⁶, travel and accommodation costs, which are thus totally at the expense of the student.

9. Official in charge of the administrative procedure
