THE PROFESSIONAL BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAMME IN
INDUSTRIAL MANUFACTURING TECHNOLOGIES
ACADEMIC YEAR 2019/20**

Rector's Decree no. 716 dated 08th July 2019

THE RECTOR

- Having regard to the University Statute;
- Having regard to the current General Academic Regulations of the University;
- Having regard to Law No. 189 of 30th July 2002, concerning "Changes to legislation on immigration and asylum";
- Having regard to Ministerial decree no. 270 of 22nd October, 2004, "Amendments to the Regulations on the educational autonomy of Universities";
- Having regard to Ministerial decrees dated 16th March 2007, "Determination of degree classifications" and "Determination of single-cycle Master's degree classification";
- Having regard to Ministerial decree no. 47 of 30th January 2013;
- Having regard to Law no. 104 of 5th February 1992 concerning "Framework law for assistance, social integration and rights of persons with disabilities" and subsequent modifications and integrations, in particular Paragraph 5 of Article 16;
- Having regard to Law no. 170 of 8th October 2010, concerning "Provisions on specific learning disorders in schools" and specifically, paragraph 4 of article 5;
- Having regard to the respective resolutions of the Academic Senate on 22nd November 2016, and of the Board of Governors on 29th November 2016, in which enrolment is open to applicants who hold a diploma obtained after attending school for at least 12 years. This qualification must allow admission to a university programme in the issuing country; such university programme must be equivalent to the programme requested in Italy; moreover, the diploma must have been achieved after having attended at least one year in a foreign system, except as provided for by bilateral agreements;
- Having regard to the respective resolutions of the Academic Senate dated 19th September 2017 and of the Board of Governors dated 20th September 2017, concerning the fee charged for registration for the admission test in Italy and abroad;
- Having regard to the "Procedures for entry, stay and enrolment of international/foreign students in higher education courses in Italy –academic year 2019/2020" dated 11th March 2019;
- Having regard to Rector's decree no. 907 dated 1st October 2018 – "Initiation of admissions procedures - Admissions to Bachelor's degree programmes with locally programmed admissions – a.y. 2019/2020" and subsequent amendments – which decrees, among other things, the following: opening of admissions procedures; knowledge of the Italian language as an admission requirement; opening of the Apply procedure; TIL registration fee (Test in Laib) in Italy and abroad; appointment of the Central Committee and the Laboratory Committee for TILs held in Italy and abroad;
- Having regard to the respective resolutions of the Academic Senate dated 18th December 2018 and of the Board of Governors dated 19th December 2018 concerning the approval of the course catalogue for a.y. 2019/2020;
- Having regard to the respective resolutions of the Academic Senate dated 24th January 2019 and of the Board of Governors dated 30th January 2019 which approve: a) the number of programmed admissions for a.y. 2019/2020; b) the number of quota students for a.y. 2019/2020; c) the possibility for students to attend the common first-year courses of the Engineering Bachelor's degree programmes taught in Italian in the city of Mondovì (except for the Bachelor's degree programme in Industrial Production Engineering), d) the institution of the new Professional Bachelor's degree programme in Industrial Manufacturing Technologies (L-9);

- Considering that on 19th February 2019 the title of the new Professional Bachelor’s degree programme (L-9) has been modified in *Tecnologie per l’industria manifatturiera* (Industrial Manufacturing Technologies) in compliance with the requirements (30th January 2019) of the Italian National University Council (*CUN – Consiglio Universitario Nazionale*) and that on 26th February 2019 the new title has been approved by the same Italian National University Council;
- Considering that the present Degree programme is offered in a.y. 2019/2020 for the first time;
- Considering that Politecnico will only offer first-year courses of this programme in a.y. 2019/2020;
- Taking into account that this new Bachelor’s degree programme is still at an experimental stage and considering the necessity to share information about it;
- Considering that for this programme there is no historical trend available due to its recent activation;
- Considering that the *Commissione istruttoria per il coordinamento dell’attività didattica e formativa* (a Committee for teaching coordination of Politecnico) approved the calendar of the admission test (TIL) Test in Laib – Professional Bachelor’s degree (1st April 2019);
- Having regard to the respective resolutions of the Academic Senate dated 3rd April 2019 and of the Board of Governors dated 10th April 2019 concerning the structure of the admission test for this programme;
- Having regard to Rector’s decree no. 487 dated 9th May 2019 which decrees the following: a) appointment of the person in charge of the procedure for admissions to Politecnico Bachelor’s degree programmes; b) appointment of designated members of the Central Committee for TILs held in Italy and abroad;
- Considering that the resolutions mentioned in this introduction have been made available on the University website in order to provide necessary information to prospective students and their families;

DECREES

Art. 1

(Initiation of the procedure and places available)

1. A Call is made for admissions to the Professional Bachelor’s degree programme in **Industrial Manufacturing Technologies** (*Tecnologie per l’industria manifatturiera*) for a.y. 2019/2020 for the number of places indicated in the following table:

2. Admissions to the programme referred to in this article are subject to prior accreditation of the same pursuant to current provisions;
3. The score obtained in the TIL-LP test (Test in Laib – Professional Bachelor’s degree/*Test in Laib - Laurea professionalizzante*) is only valid for enrolment in a.y. 2019/2020

Art.2

(Admission test dates and venue)

1. The TIL-LP will take place on **Tuesday 24th September 2019** - see page <http://orienta.polito.it/>

- The admission test is held in the University's computer laboratories (LAIB) **of the main campus of Politecnico di Torino**, located in corso Duca degli Abruzzi, 24. Applicants will find information about the test location on their Apply@polito personal page.

Art. 3
(Taking the national admission test)

- All applicants are required to apply for the TIL-LP test by registering online on the Apply@polito platform. To complete their application, applicants are also required to pay the registration fee referred to in paragraph 3 and 4.
- Applicants can register on the Apply@polito platform and apply for the TIL-LP test according to the following schedule and depending on their category:

- Detailed information on how to register on the Apply@polito platform, how to participate and how the TIL-LP test takes place is available at <http://orienta.polito.it/>.

The TIL-LP registration fee is € 50.00.

The amount paid cannot be reimbursed under any circumstances, nor can it be considered valid for TIL sessions other than the one for which the applicant has registered.

- The registration fee can be paid with various payment methods, including:

- Credit cards (Visa and MasterCard only – American Express is not accepted), generating an immediate payment;
- Pre-printed notice of payment, such as for instance the MAV, generating a deferred payment.
- PagoPA, an electronic payment system that allows users of online banking services to choose a bank or a payment institution (defined as “Payment Service Provider” – PSP) among those recognized at national level.

The use of a deferred payment method (for instance, a pre-printed notice of payment) is valid solely and exclusively if it is supported by a **self-declaration** of the payment date certifying that the payment was made before the deadline and in the Italian territory. This declaration must be submitted by the same deadline. Should the self-declaration be found to be false or incorrect, the registration for the test, or the test itself, will be cancelled.

At the end of the TIL-LP registration process, applicants will receive a registration confirmation by e-mail.

Art. 4

(Applicants with disabilities or with Specific Learning Difficulties)

1. The TIL-LP is organized in compliance with current legislation on disabilities and specific learning difficulties. The procedures to take the TIL-LP test for students referred to in this paragraph are illustrated on the University website (<https://didattica.polito.it/disabili/it/presentazione>); the same website also lists the Administration Offices that applicants can contact to request special arrangements for test.

In particular:

- Applicants with disabilities, referred to in article 16 of Law no.104/92, must promptly submit their certificate to Politecnico for the organization of the admission test. The medical certificate must be issued by the local medical commission and must certify the type and decree of invalidity .
This applicants are entitled to get maximum 30% extra time compared to standard test time (maximum test duration: 120 minutes).
 - applicants with certified specific learning difficulties (SpLD), referred to in Law no. 170/2010, must provide valid evidence of SpDL in the form a medical certificate issued not later than 3 years ago by the Italian Health Care System (SSN) or by a specialist or health care facility recognized by the Italian system. These applicants are entitled to get maximum 30% extra time compared to standard test time (maximum test duration: 120 minutes)
 - applicants with disabilities or specific learning difficulties (SpLD) who reside abroad are required to submit evidence of disability or SpLD issued in their country, together with a sworn translation into Italian or English. The university bodies in charge of examining the above-mentioned certificates ascertain that foreign documents provide evidence of a disability or a SpLD which is accepted by Italian law.
2. Applicants referred to in this paragraph who require special arrangements to take the TIL-LP test must upload their evidence of disability or SpLD to the Apply@polito platform (“Attachments” section) by 12.00am (12:00 noon - Italian time) of Friday **20th September**.

Art. 5

(TIL-LP contents)

1. The TIL-LP is an individual test, available in Italian. It is different for each applicant. It is made up of automatically and randomly selected computer interface questions. All tests have an equivalent level of difficulty.
1. Applicants have to solve 42 questions, divided into 4 sections. Each section has a certain number of questions to be finished in a pre-set time:
 - 18 Maths and logic questions in 39 minutes
 - 8 Computer science technology questions in 17 minutes
 - 8 Technological culture questions in 17 minutes
 - 8 Design Knowledge questions in 17 minutes

The total time for the TIL-LP test is set at one hour and thirty minutes.

Each question has 5 possible answers marked with the letters A, B, C, D and E, only one of which is correct.

Art. 6

(Evaluation and minimum admission threshold)

1. Admission decisions are based on the position of each applicant **on the merit ranking** list for place allocations. The ranking list is made according to the number of places available.
2. The evaluation of the admission test is based on the following criteria:
 - 1 point for each correct answer
 - A penalty of 0,25 points (-0,25) for each incorrect answer
 - 0 points for each unanswered question

The score is converted to hundredths and calculated up to the second decimal position. At the end of the test, applicants will see their result on their screens. The test result will also be available on the applicant’s personal page of the Apply@polito platform.

3. Applicants who score more than zero can be admitted to the Professional Bachelor's degree programme, provided that there are places available.

Art. 7

(TIL-LP results and date of publication of the ranking list)

1. TIL-LP results are made public through the publication of a list of all students for the allocation of available places.
2. TIL-LP results will be made public with a Rector's decree, on the online Bulletin (*Albo online*) of the University, on the Apply@polito personal page of each applicant and on the University webpage <http://orienta.polito.it>

Art. 8

(How the ranking lists are made)

1. For the purposes of the ranking lists, the following student categories have been given the following meaning:

European Union students: Italian citizens or other EU nationals

Equivalent students:

- applicants from Norway, Iceland, Lichtenstein, Switzerland and San Marino;
- non-UE applicants legally residing in Italy with residence permit issued for study, work or family reasons;
- political refugees;
- staff members of foreign diplomatic missions (Embassies/ Consulates) or International Organizations based in Italy and accredited to the Italian Government or to the Holy See (including family members: husband, wife and children);
- non-UE applicants legally residing in Italy or diplomats who have an Italian high school diploma awarded by an Italian school in Italy or aboard (L. 189/2002);

2. The ranking lists referred to in article 7, paragraph 1, are made with the following criteria:
 - a. applicants are ranked in descending order according to their TIL-LP score;
 - b. in case of equal ranking, the score obtained in the individual sections that make up the TIL-LP test shall prevail, considered in the following order: Mathematics and Logic, Computer science technology, Technological culture and e Design Knowledge. In case of a further equal ranking, the younger student applicant will be chosen.
3. The ranking lists referred to in paragraph 1 classify the students into the following categories:
 - **ASSIGNED STUDENT:** a student who **MUST** enrol in the Bachelor's degree programme which has been assigned to him/her; failure to enrol by the deadline will result in the allocation of his/her student place to another applicant – **therefore, failure to enrol by the deadlines entails permanent renunciation of the place.**
 - **STUDENT ON WAITING LIST:** a student who has not been offered a place in the Professional bachelor's degree programme, but could be assigned a place in the next call/s. This student must wait for the next call/s.
 - **RENUNCIATION OF WAITING LIST:** a student who explicitly renounced his/her right to be on the waiting list - see paragraph 5.
 - **RENUNCIATION OF ENROLMENT:** a student who has been ASSIGNED a student place but has failed to enrol in the programme by the deadline.
 - **NOT ADMITTED STUDENT:** a student for whom there are no more places available in the programme.
4. Allocations of places to students included in the ranking lists referred to in article 7, paragraph 1 are based on further updates of the ranking lists which take into account the number of students who enrol by the deadlines of article 9.
5. Students included in the ranking lists referred to in article 7, paragraph 1, who are no longer interested in enrolling at Politecnico di Torino and **intend to renounce their right to be on the waiting list**, can do so from the Apply@polito platform; when an applicant renounces his/her right to be on the waiting list,

he/she irrevocably gives up his/her position on the ranking list; therefore his/her student place is assigned to another applicant on the ranking list.

- The ranking list closing date for EU, equivalent and quota students is the deadline for any change or update of the ranking lists. Ranking lists will be closed on **Tuesday 29th October 2019**.

Art. 9 (Enrolment process)

- The requirements for enrolment in the Bachelor's degree programme in Industrial manufacturing technologies are listed in Annex A attached to this Call, of which it is integral part.
- The enrolment process has two phases and it is considered completed upon conclusion of both phases.
- First phase - online enrolment:**

a. Deadlines

The first phase of online enrolment **for all applicants, except for quota students, has the following opening and closing dates. Applicants who do not meet these deadlines will be excluded from the enrolment process.**

There might be further updates of the ranking list, if necessary. The new deadlines for enrolment will be published exclusively on the University website <http://orienta.polito.it/>

PLEASE NOTE: applicants who have not earned their upper secondary school diploma or do not have a fiscal code on the enrolment closing date for the various applicant categories (see tables above) can enrol at Politecnico di Torino "with condition" (conditional enrolment). They are required to drop this provisional condition **not later than 2.00 p.m. of Thursday 14th November 2019** by adding the missing information on their Apply@polito personal page. Applicants who fail to do so will be excluded from the enrolment process even if they already paid the first instalment of their tuition fees.

b. How to enrol

- Applicants are required to enrol online. At the same time, they must pay the first instalment of their tuition fees. The standard amount of the first instalment is 200 €. Possible reductions or revisions of this amount will be announced in the Tuition Fee Guide for academic year 2019/2020, which is going to be approved by the university bodies at a later date.
- The payment can be made using the following payment methods:
 - Credit cards: Visa and MasterCard only (American Express is not accepted), generating an immediate payment.
 - Pre-printed notice of payment, for instance the MAV, generating a deferred payment.

- PagoPA, an electronic payment system that allows users of online banking services to choose a bank or a payment institution (defined as “Payment Service Provider” – PSP) among those recognized at national level.

Practical details will be published exclusively on the University website <http://orienta.polito.it/>.

At the end of the first phase of online enrolment, students will be informed about its conclusion by e-mail.

The use of a deferred payment method (for instance, a pre-printed notice of payment) is valid solely and exclusively if it is supported by a **self-declaration** of the payment date certifying that the payment was made before the deadline and in Italian territory. This declaration must be submitted by the same deadline. Should the self-declaration be found to be false or incorrect, the first phase of online enrolment will be cancelled and the applicant will lose the right to enrol at Politecnico for academic year 2019/20.

At the end of the first phase of enrolment, applicants, who meet all the admission requirements and are not awaiting the evaluation of previous academic records, will receive their ID student number and must move to the second phase of enrolment.

Students who are awaiting the evaluation of previous academic records (article 10) are required to accept their offer of admission by paying the first instalment of their tuition fees before the enrolment deadline. **If they do not meet these deadlines, they will be excluded from the enrolment process.**

4. **Second phase - enrolment at the Office of the University Registrar:**

Enrolment becomes effective when students go to the **Office of the University Registrar**. In some cases, students are required to show the documents listed in ~~Annex B~~ Annex A attached to this Call (“Original documents to be presented for enrolment” section)

All students (except for students with a pending evaluation of previous academic records - article 10) must complete this enrolment phase **not later than Monday 18th November 2019**. **Students who do not meet these deadlines will be excluded from the enrolment process.**

a. Special instructions for students with a non-Italian educational qualification

- Before completing the second phase of enrolment, applicants with a non-Italian educational qualification **MUST** go to the **Incoming Mobility Office** – International Affairs Department before the above-mentioned deadline. This Office evaluates the documents listed in Annex A and Annex B attached to this Call, of which they are integral parts.

b. Conditional enrolment

- In the absence of the documents referred to in points e), i) and l) of Annex A (“Original documents to be presented for enrolment” section), students are **considered enrolled with condition** at Politecnico di Torino. This provisional condition must be dropped by 2nd March 2020 by presenting the above-mentioned documents. If these students do not present their upper secondary school diploma (Annex A - point e) by the deadline, their enrolment at Politecnico will be cancelled with immediate effect on any previous academic progress. If students do not to present the official translation into Italian of their upper secondary school diploma (Annex A - point i) and the statement of validity/ *dichiarazione di valore* of their upper secondary school diploma or certificate issued by ENIC-NARIC (Annex A - point l) before the deadline, they will be denied access to their personal page of the Teaching Portal and will be placed on a hold until they present these documents, without prejudice to the provisions of the Student Regulations on forfeiture.
 - Students with a non-Italian educational qualification who are still waiting for the Regional School Office to issue the declaration of equivalence of their upper secondary school diploma, (enrolment requirement) are **considered enrolled with condition** at Politecnico di Torino. This provisional condition must be dropped by 2nd March 2020. If these students do not present this declaration by the deadline, their enrolment at Politecnico will be cancelled with immediate effect on their previous academic progress.
 - Applicants who do not meet or only partially fulfil the requirements and/or documents listed in Annex A and in Annex B attached to this Call lose the right to move to the second phase of enrolment and are excluded from the enrolment process permanently.
5. **Underage applicants:** applicants who are underage on the date of online enrolment must reserve their student place by paying the first instalment of the tuition fees; in order to complete the second phase of enrolment, applicants can:

- go to the Office of the University Registrar accompanied by an adult or by a legal guardian; or else,
- go to the Office of the University Registrar bringing a self-certificate (*dichiarazione sostitutiva di certificazioni* - Articles 5 and 46 of Presidential Decree no. 445 of 28th December 2000). The self-certificate can be downloaded from the applicant's Apply@polito personal page and must be signed by a parent or legal guardian; a photocopy of the identification document of the signer must be attached as well.

Underage applicants with a non-Italian educational qualification are required to contact the **Incoming Mobility Office** – International Affairs Department.

6. In case of non-compliance with the deadlines referred to in this article or with the requirements listed in Annex A and Annex B attached to this Call, of which they are integral part, applicants lose their right to enrol and will not be entitled to ask for any refund of the first instalment of the tuition fees referred to in this article, whatever the reason brought forward as a justification.

Art. 10

**(Students currently enrolled in a Bachelor's degree programme or students with a university degree
Students currently enrolled in an IFTS programme - Istruzione e Formazione tecnica superiore, Higher technical education and training)**

1. Students currently enrolled in a Bachelor's degree programme at Politecnico or at another University who intend to transfer to the Professional Bachelor's degree programme in **Industrial Manufacturing Technologies** at Politecnico di Torino **must take the TIL-LP test**;

EU students and Equivalent students with an Italian or non-Italian university degree, as well as **students enrolled in an IFTS programme** who intend to transfer to the Professional Bachelor's degree programme in **Industrial Manufacturing Technologies** at Politecnico di Torino **must take the TIL-LP test** (also if they come from a programme belonging to the same class) and must conveniently place themselves on the ranking list.

During the application process on the Apply@polito platform, these students are required to choose the Professional Bachelor's degree programme in Industrial Manufacturing Technologies in the "Select your course" section and must provide the details of their current Bachelor's degree programme (university, name and class of their degree programme, exams already passed with the corresponding number of credits and scientific disciplinary field, courses for which the exams are still pending, course syllabi). Students currently enrolled in an IFTS programme must provide the details of their current IFTS programme (Institution name: state secondary school, regional centre for vocational education and training, university, public or private firm or company where they attended the IFTS programme; name of their IFTS programme exams already passed; courses for which the exams are still pending; course syllabi). Students who pass the test and are on the ranking list for admission to the programme must confirm their intention to transfer to Politecnico on the Apply@polito platform. They are required to accept their offer of admission in accordance with the terms of article 9. **If they fail to comply with these terms, they will be excluded from the enrolment process.**

After confirming the transfer, the previous academic records of these applicants are sent to the Academic Advisor of the programme who decides on the possible recognition of previously earned credits.

More information and deadlines for enrolment will be available in the Student Guide - a.y. 2019/20, which is going to be published in July.

Art. 11

(Applicants taking multiple admission tests)

1. Applicants who took multiple tests for admission to various Bachelor's degree programmes offered by Politecnico may be eligible for enrolment in the Professional Bachelor's degree programme in Industrial Manufacturing Technologies and on a waiting list for one or more programmes. In this case, they must enrol before the deadline in order to avoid losing their place. Subsequently, if they find out that they have

been admitted to another degree programme, they must go to the Office of Student Services in person to modify their choice **before the deadline for enrolment**.

2. Applicants who took the TIL-LP test and are awaiting the results of the admission tests to other universities must enrol before the deadline in order to avoid losing their place. Subsequently, if these applicants find out that they have been admitted to another university, they need to go to the Office of Student Services and make a request for withdrawal/transfer to the other university. Tuition fees previously paid by these students will not be refunded under any circumstances.

Art. 13

(Committees)

1. The members of the Central Committee were appointed with Rector's Decrees no. 907/18 and no. 487/19. Successive Rector's Decrees will appoint the members of the Laboratory Committees who will be responsible for administering the TIL-LP test.

Art. 14

(Privacy policy and access to documents)

1. In accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (EU Regulation 2016/679) and the "Code regarding the protection of personal data" (Legislative Decree No. 196 of 30th June 2003), Politecnico di Torino will process applicants' personal data in pursuit of its institutional aims and in accordance with the transparency purposes imposed by the law. 2. Access to all documents is allowed in the forms provided for by current legislation.

6. An appeal against this Call for applications can be made to the Regional Administrative Court (TAR) or the President of the Republic, respectively, within 60 days or 120 days from the date of publication.
