Student Exchange Program at BEIHANG UNIVERSITY



Students from partner universities of Beihang University are welcome to study as exchange students at Beihang. While studying in Beijing, they will enjoy a unique opportunity not only to enrich their academic life but also gain first-hand experience of China, one of the world's earliest continuous civilizations and fastest-growing major economies.

Eligibility Criteria

- Students must be enrolled full-time at a university which has signed a formal student exchange agreement with Beihang.
- Students must be enrolled in a formal degree program at their home university during their study at Beihang.
- · Students must have a good academic record.
- Students must have sufficient English skills, at least B1 level, before enrolling in English-taught courses. At the minimum, a score of 5 on the HSK is required to be accepted into Chinese– taught courses.
- Only applications made to Beihang through home universities will be accepted.


Academic Programs

Expenses

- Exchange students pay tuition fees to their home university only.
- Exchange students should cover their own expenses as follows: travel, accommodation, food, books, insurance, and other associated costs. An average meal in the student dining hall costs 10-15 RMB.
- Students will be required to register with the Comprehensive Insurance & Protection Scheme for Foreigners Staying in China on arrival. The cost is 400 RMB/6 months.
