

# PORTFOLIO REQUIRED FOR BUILDING ENGINEERING\_Green Building path

Applicants must meet the Politecnico di Torino general admission requirements for international applicants, and are selected also on the basis of a digital portfolio.

The digital portfolio should include samples of works from your previous educational program. Working experiences may be added to the portfolio. A portfolio should reflect the scope and variety of your previous training and experience with <u>specific emphasis on your knowledge of and skills in building design and architectural technology.</u>

You should submit a work that represents your personal interests as well as your design and technological abilities. Neatness and clarity of the presentation are extremely important as they reflect both your attitude towards your work as well as your ability to communicate your work in a comprehensive and deliberate manner. The portfolio text should be written in English.

## The required portfolio includes:

#### A cover

The portfolio cover should include your full name and contact information.

## A total maximum of 5 projects, including:

- no more than 2 professional projects
- at least one individual project
- your final project (if you have not yet completed it, include your most recent project).

At least one of the projects included should clearly demonstrate your capabilities with respects to structural and technical (energy, technology, management) project viability.

The number of boards per project is up to you, please choose the most significant ones.

## How to present your projects in the portfolio

#### Per project define:

- title and location of the project topic
- if it is an academic or professional work
- if it is an individual or group work
- the year/semester of your study and the date in which the project was carried out

## Per project include:

- concept sketches, showing preliminary visual (and textual when relevant) development of ideas, approaches and methods, describing how you organize your ideas.
- finished drawings of original design work, documenting in a clear and precise manner both the intention and the resolution of each project.
- a written explanation (in English) of the design concept and solution. Here you should include the inspiration behind the project as well as the goals and objectives of the design.

Please note that for all drawings you are required to include the name of the author.

Please be aware that quality is more important than quantity.

Note that portfolios are evaluated digitally and should be easily readable without zooming or scrolling. Therefore, the size of your portfolio should not exceed **20 MB**
