# **Description of Notes field:**

<u>\* Conditional admission:</u> because the Master Degree is not yet acquired. The eventual enrollment to a PhD program could take place only if the Master Degree is achieved **within <u>31<sup>st</sup> October 2023</u>**. The failure of achievement by the deadline would result in the irrevocable loss of the right to enroll.

<u>\*\* Conditional admission</u>: because the English certificates required to enrol in a PhD programme is not yet acquired.

In case of admission in a PhD programme, the candidate will be allowed to enrol only if submitting **by and no later than** <u>31<sup>st</sup> October 2023</u> one among the certificates required, pursuant to art. 6, paragraph 1, letter b) of the call for admission. The failure to submit the certificate shall entail the loss of the right to enrolment.
