Applicants that will have to apply for the study visa to enroll in PoliTO











European or equivalent applicants with Non-Italian qualification

Equivalent students definition:

- students from Norway, Iceland, Lichtenstein, Switzerland and San Marino
- non-EU nationals legally residing in Italy with a valid residence permit for study, work or family reasons or political refugees
- staff members of Foreign Diplomatic Missions and International Organizations based in Italy



## How can you register for the test?

Non-EU

EU /equivalent

**REGISTER** on the Apply@poliTO platform and fill in all the required data

**LOGIN** and **SELECT** the courses (maximum 5 for Engineering) under the Apply section named "Select your course"

**SELECT** the test through TIL section and **SUBMIT** the application

**<u>REGISTER</u>** to the admission test

<u>PAY</u> the specific registration fee, respecting the terms and deadlines indicated in the Call for applications for admissions to the Bachelor's degree programmes

**THRESHOLDS** 30/100 to be placed in the ranking list

60/100 guaranteed threshold for Engineering and Urban Planning

70/100 guaranteed threshold for Design

**CERTIFICATIONS** Admission test for Engineering, Planning and Design can be

substituted by SAT/ACT/GRE/GMAT (see call for admissions article 13)

## Which are the language requirements?

BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAMMES	MINIMUM REQUIREMENT
English-taught programmes	English Level B2 or higher
Italian-taught programmes	<b>Italian Level B1</b> or higher
Italian-taught programmes with 1st year in English English-taught programmes with 1st year in Italian	English Level B2 or higher +
	<b>Italian Level B1</b> or higher



WHEN TO SUBMIT: within place reservation

ARCHITECTURE EU/EQUIVALENT APPLICANTS: EU/Equivalent applicants that chose the English-taught programme will be offered a place according to their position on the ranking list. When the English-taught programme is full (40 available places), these applicants will be offered a place in the Italian-taught programme, following the ranking list until all places are saturated. In this case, they will have to provide a valid Italian language certification within place reservation.



# **Enrolment steps**

#### **PLACE RESERVATION – WHO:**

- Applicants who reached TIL guaranteed admission threshold (only for Engineering/ Design/ Urban Planning)
- Applicants who applied with an accepted international certification (SAT, GRE, ACT, GMAT)
  with required scores (only for Engineering/ Design/ Urban Planning)
- Applicants in the published ranking lists

Enrolment process can be started only by applicants who have uploaded the language certificate within deadlines for student place reservation

## **Compulsory Enrolment Documents**


Students who meet language requirements and who have got their student ID number, will have to upload the documents in their **Teaching Portal/Online Services/Attachments**, as specified in the Enrolment Regulations for Bachelor's Degree Programmes – A.Y. 2024/25 (art. 9,10)

within 27th September 2024

The documents will be checked before 11th November 2024.

WARNING: the deadline to upload study visa type D is 29th November 2024.

## Which are the immigration requirements?

#### Non-EU

WHO: Non-EU applicants living outside Italy

#### WHAT:

Register on **Universitaly** website with PoliTO's Username (FXXXXXX) in step B Select the course Attach the needed documents Check with the Embassy if other documents are required

#### WHEN:


Submit your application as soon as you are granted admission.

Bachelor's applicants in the ranking list can submit it according to the ranking lists updates

Validation happens for ENROLLED students, who uploaded all mandatory documents + language certificate + paid tuition fees. Enrolment depends on ranking lists' updates.
