

#### PRACTICAL INFORMATION – CODICE FISCALE

The Fiscal Code (Codice Fiscale) is a code made up of letters and numbers and it is used to identify the citizens living in Italy.

The Fiscal Code is needed for:

- enrolling at PoliTO
- opening a bank account
- receiveing the payment from a scholarship
- signing a rental contract

#### You can obtain it:

- At the Italian Embassy/Consulate of your country
- At your arrival at the local Revenue Agency (Offices of the Agenzia delle Entrate)

#### WHERE TO APPLY AT YOUR ARRIVAL

In September a desk of Agenzia delle Entrate is available **at PoliTO** → you can reserve an appointment throught your PoliTO student page (*Portale della Didattica*)

#### **DOCUMENTS NEEDED at the appointment**

- Passport/ID card and a photocopy of it
- Visa (non-EU students) and a photocopy of it
- Form filled in



#### **IMMIGRATION PROCEDURE**

- **European Union citizens** are not required to apply for the residence permit. For stayings <u>longer than 3 months</u> registration at "Ufficio Anagrafe" requested.
- Non-EU citizens have to apply for the <u>residence permit</u> or for the Declaration of Presence within 8 working days from their arrival in Italy.

PoliTO has the Immigration Desk that offer assistance or information relating immigration procedures.





# IMMIGRATION PROCEDURE EU STUDENTS

The citizens of the European Union can stay in our country for **up to three months without any conditions or formalities**, provided they possess a valid identity document for travel issued by their own country.

#### **TEMPORARY REGISTRATION AT ANAGRAFE**

- If the stay lasts **longer than 3 months but less than 12 months** you must register as temporary residents at the registry office (ufficio dell'Anagrafe) of the town of residence.
- The registration has the validity of one year maximum, then the Anagrafe provides for the automatic cancellation from the list.

#### PERMANENT REGISTRATION AT ANAGRAFE

When the stay exceeds 12 months, the citizen can no longer be considered temporary and must therefore apply
for registration in the register of resident population (additional info <a href="here">here</a>)



#### HEALTH INSURANCE — EU CITIZENS

- Students from the European Union member countries, who upon the arrival have the TEAM card or the E106 Form (statement of the original European Health Card issued by their country)
- Health care is guaranteed for emergencies and urgent sickness benefits, accident, maternity. The
  country of residence is responsible for paying for the costs
- The assistance of a family doctor is guaranteed if you have an ID card (identity card) and the original European Health Card (TEAM) or a substitutive statement (Modello E106). In this case it is possible to go directly to a family doctor affiliated with the National Health Service, both for health problems and/or to ask for medical prescriptions. The ASL (Local Health Authority) will request the reimbursement to the competent foreign institution, according to the rules of the National Health Service of the country of provenance of the student
