


## SECOND MASTER'S GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM MAP



#### BU International Student & Scholar Office (<u>ISSO</u>)

 Provides current requirements & guidance on CPT & OPT eligibility

#### **Curricular Practical Training (CPT)**

- 4 credit internship option for students pursuing oncampus <u>Administrative Sciences</u> master's degree
- Full-time, semester-long internship placements in Boston

#### **Optional Practical Training (OPT)**

- 12 months of off-campus employment for the purpose of gaining practical experience in student's field of study
  - Graduates of STEM degrees may be eligible for an additional 24 months of off-campus employment via OPT
- Eligibility: Student has completed appropriate program on-campus and is in good academic standing at BU
