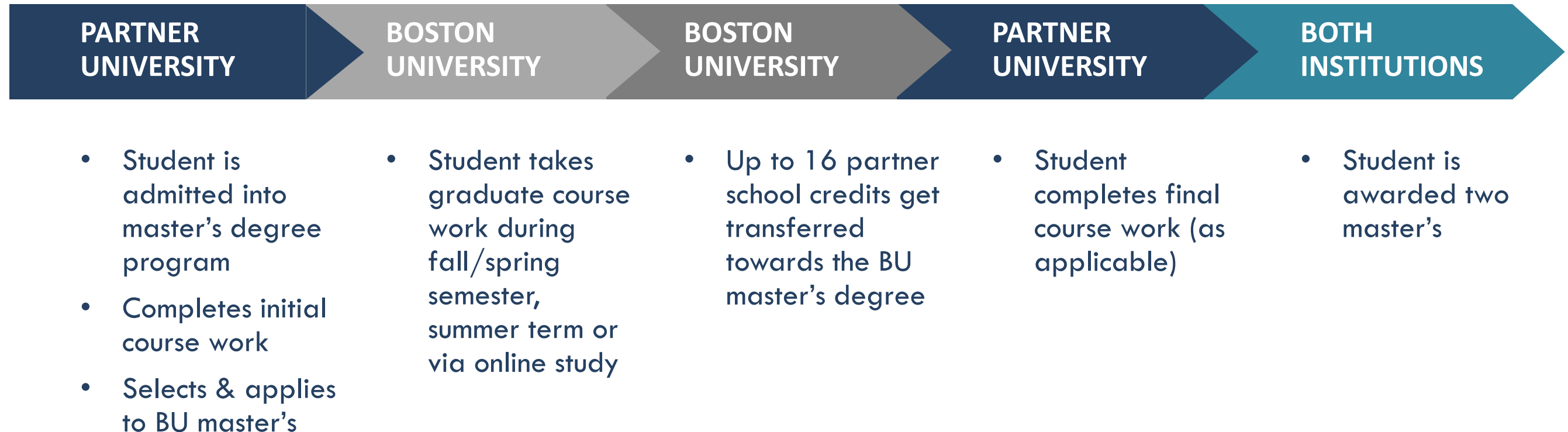

SECOND MASTER'S GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM MAP

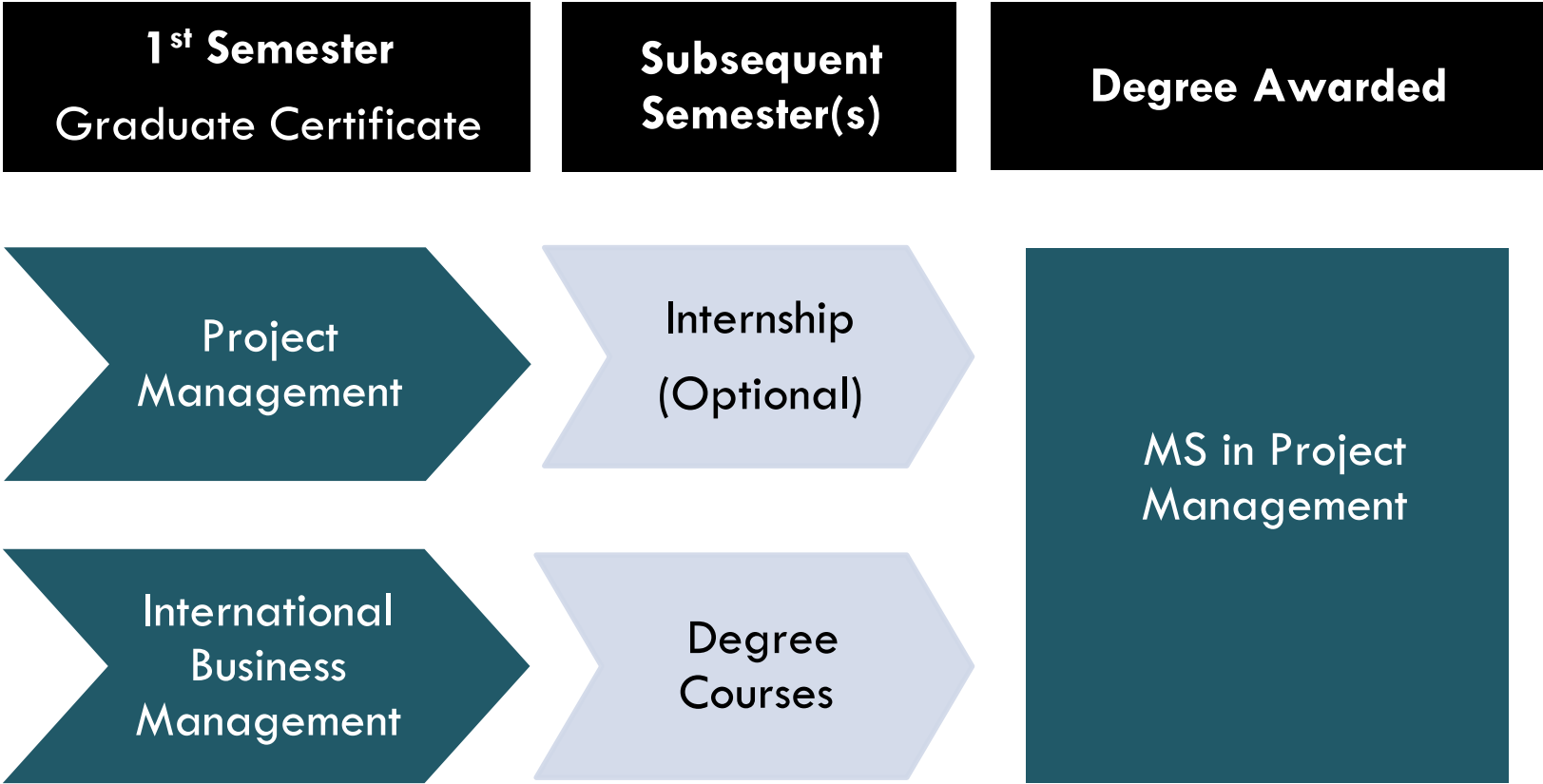

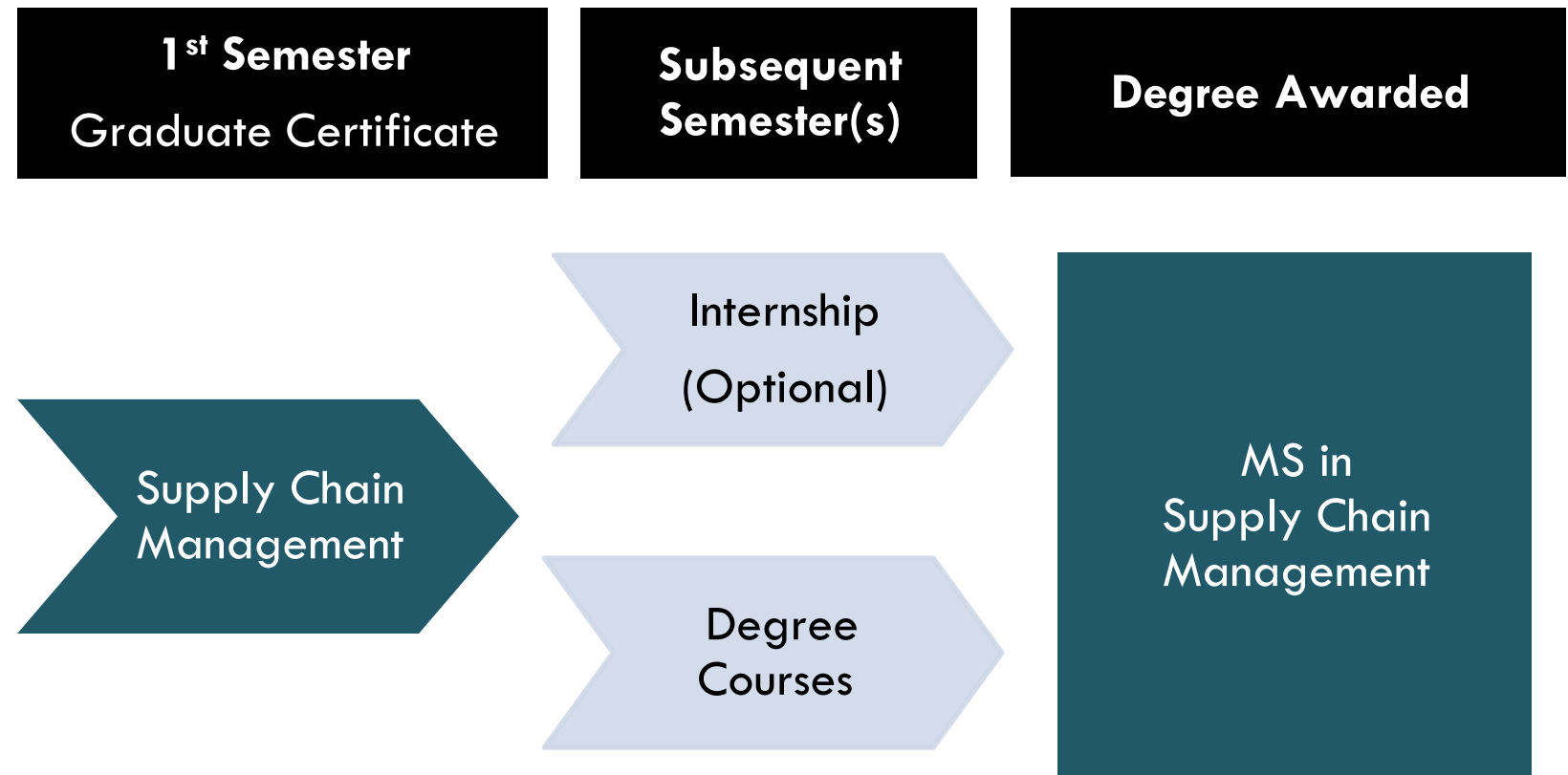

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCES

BU International Student & Scholar Office (ISSO)

- Provides current requirements & guidance on CPT & OPT eligibility

Curricular Practical Training (CPT)

- 4 credit internship option for students pursuing on-campus Administrative Sciences master's degree
- Full-time, semester-long internship placements in Boston

Optional Practical Training (OPT)

- 12 months of off-campus employment for the purpose of gaining practical experience in student's field of study
 - Graduates of STEM degrees may be eligible for an additional 24 months of off-campus employment via OPT
- Eligibility: Student has completed appropriate program on-campus and is in good academic standing at BU

MET International & BU academic department review application materials & MET International distributes admission decisions.

4

Admitted students receive I-20 from BU, which allows student to apply for an F1 visa at U.S. consulate or embassy.

5

Admitted students start classes and must attend mandatory orientation activities.
