



ACADEMIC EVALUATION

Made by Academic Commission to verify the previous degree

FAQ

IS THERE A NEEDED GPA TO APPLY?

No, the Academic commission takes into consideration the previous career, the previous University global ranking and the average GPA of each Academic Year's applicants

CAN I APPLY ON BOTH CALLS?

No, applicants can only apply in one of the two available calls (which are exactly equivalent) for a maximum of 2 courses
