Non-European applicants with Non-Italian qualification

Applicants that will have to apply for the study visa to enroll in PoliTO











European or equivalent applicants with Non-Italian qualification

Equivalent student definition:

- students from Norway, Iceland, Lichtenstein, Switzerland and San Marino
- non-EU nationals legally residing in Italy with a valid residence permit for study, work or family reasons;
- political refugees;
- staff members of Foreign Diplomatic Missions (Embassies/Consulates) and International Organizations based in Italy, legally accredited to the Italian Government or to the Holy See (including family members: spouse and children);
- non-EU nationals legally residing in Italy or diplomats who have an Italian high school diploma awarded in Italy or abroad (Law no. 189/2002).

What's new this a.y.?

- 🔖 · 2 available dates for the TIL (Test in Laib) for Architecture: July 22 and 24
 - Only one of the two available dates may be selected
- Once the date and time slot have been chosen, the booking cannot be changed
 - The TIL -A (Test in Laib) will be held **exclusively in Person** for all categories of candidates

How is the test structured?

100 minutes to answer 50 questions. 5 sections/5 different disciplines.

- 10 Reading comprehension questions (20 minutes)
- 10 Prior school knowledge, History (including art history) and General Knowledge questions
- 10 Logic reasoning questions (20 minutes)
- 10 Drawing and Representation questions (20 minutes)
- 10 Mathematics and Physics questions (20 minutes)

Each question has 5 possible answers and only one is correct.

Correct answer: 1 point / Incorrect answer: - 0.25 points / no answer: 0 points

Results available in the TIL section of the application as soon as the test it's over.

How can you register for the test?

- 1. **REGISTER** on the Apply@poliTO platform and fill in all the required data
- 2. <u>LOGIN</u> and <u>SELECT</u> the degree in Architettura-Architecture under the Apply section named "Select your course"
- 3. **SELECT** the test through TIL section and **SUBMIT** the application
- 4. **REGISTER** to the admission test
- **5. PAY** the specific registration fee, respecting the terms and deadlines indicated in the Call for applications for admissions to the Bachelor's degree programme in Architettura-Architecture 2025/26.

Registration timeframe

From Wed 4th June 2025 up to 2 p.m. (Italian time) of Wed 16th July 2025



How does the test in person work?

- > after the registration to the test is complete, the location will be available in the TIL section of your online application.
- > the test is delivered in the computer labs (LAIB) of PoliTO. Please check your receipt in order to find which computer lab you have to go to
- > It is recommended to arrive at least 15 minutes before the scheduled time of your TIL session.
- > it is not mandatory to print the receipt
- bring a valid original ID document (passport for international students)
- > download the receipt and save it for the day of the test



Which are the entry requirements?

- 1) a secondary **high school diploma** (level 4 EQF) earned after at least 12 years of school attendance (special requirements for U.S/ U.K. / Scottish / International Baccalaureate secondary high school diploma, see Annexes of the <u>CALL FOR APPLICATIONS</u>)
- 2) for Countries where an **admission test** to university is compulsory, applicants must upload a certificate attesting that the admission test has been passed (for ex: YKS, Concurso Vestibular, Gao Kao, Pruebas de Selectividad, Veveosi Prosvasis, ecc).
- 3) passing the **TIL admission test**
- 4) fulfill Language requirements (see next slide)
- 5) fulfill Immigration requirements (for Non-EU applicants)



Which are the language requirements?

BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAMMES	MINIMUM REQUIREMENT
English-taught programmes	English Level B2 or higher
Italian-taught programmes	Italian Level B2 or higher

WHEN TO SUBMIT: 25th August 2025 at 2 p.m. (Italian time)

NB: FOR EU/EQUIVALENT APPLICANTS: EU/Equivalent applicants who have chosen the English-taught programme will be offered a place according to their position on the ranking list. When the English-taught programme is full (40 available places), these applicants will be offered a place in the Italian-taught programme, following the ranking list until all places are saturated. In this case, they will have to provide a valid Italian language certification within 25th August 2025 at 2 p.m. (Italian time).





Which are the immigration requirements?

Non-EU

WHO: Non-EU applicants living outside Italy

WHAT:

Register on **Universitaly** website with PoliTO's Username (FXXXXXX) in step B Select the course Attach the needed documents Check with the Embassy if other documents are required

WHEN:

Submit your application as soon as you are granted admission.

Bachelor's applicants in the ranking list can submit it according to the ranking lists updates

Validation happens for ENROLLED students, who uploaded all mandatory documents + language certificate + paid tuition fees. Enrolment depends on ranking lists' updates.



How does the ranking list work?

RANKING LIST PUBLICATION: **Tuesday 29th July 2025** on the <u>University website</u>.

DEADLINE FOR PLACE RESERVATION/ENROLMENT: **Tuesday 25th August 2025 at 2 p.m. (Italian time)** with no exception.

Enrollment / seat reservation period for those assigned a place after the publication of the ranking list	From Tuesday, July 29, 2025 to 2:00 PM on Monday, August 25, 2025
First reassignment publication	Tuesday, August 26, 2025
Enrollment / seat reservation period for those assigned a place after the first reassignment	From Tuesday, August 26 to 2:00 PM on Thursday, August 28, 2025
Second reassignment publication	Friday, August 29, 2025
Enrollment / seat reservation period for those assigned a place after the second reassignment	From Friday, August 29 to 2:00 PM on Monday, September 1, 2025
Third reassignment publication	Tuesday, September 2, 2025
Enrollment / seat reservation period for those assigned a place after the third reassignment	From Tuesday, September 2 to 2:00 PM on Thursday, September 4, 2025

The amount of tuition fees varies according to the citizenship/residence of the student. CHECK tuition fees <u>SIMULATOR</u>


