

REGISTRATION RULES IN ITALY

- Stay up to 3 months
 - ✓ No registration required
 - ✓ Valid national ID is sufficient
- Stay between 3 and 12 months
 - **Temporary registration** at the Ufficio Anagrafe
 - 🔀 Valid for max. 1 year
 - Automatic cancellation after expiry
 - Apply online (check website)
- Stay over 12 months
 - **Permanent registration** required
 - Register in the resident population registry (check website)



Health Insurance How to access Italian Health Service (SSN)

With TEAM card or E106 form

→ EU students can access SSN like Italian citizens

Family doctor access

- → Required:
- ID card
- TEAM card or E106 form

Go directly to any SSN-affiliated doctor

→ For medical issues & prescriptions

Costs & Coverage

No upfront payment

→ ASL handles reimbursement with your home country

Solution Coverage includes:


