

REGISTRATION RULES IN ITALY



Stay up to 3 months

- ✓ No registration required
- ✓ Valid national ID is sufficient

Stay between 3 and 12 months

-  **Temporary registration** at the *Ufficio Anagrafe*
-  Valid for max. 1 year
-  Automatic cancellation after expiry
-  Apply online (check website)

Stay over 12 months

-  **Permanent registration** required
-  Register in the *resident population registry* (check website)

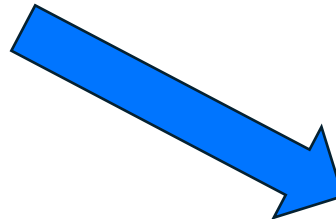
People with **dual nationality** (Italian or EU + ExtraEU) do not need to apply for the residence permit.

HEALTH INSURANCE

How to access Italian Health Service (SSN)

✓ With TEAM card or E106 form

→ EU students can access SSN like Italian citizens

Family doctor access

→ Required:

- ID card
- TEAM card or E106 form

Go directly to any SSN-affiliated doctor

→ For medical issues & prescriptions

Costs & Coverage

No upfront payment

→ ASL handles reimbursement with your home country

Coverage includes:

- Emergencies
- Urgent illness
- Accidents
- Maternity care
