Objectives

Research project on built housing typologies and architectures in Torino 1850-today (and after). Construction of a comprehensive graphic and photographic atlas of modern residential architectures from the late XIXth to the XIst century, based on literature, archival evidence and on-site surveys; with maps and re-drawing in scale of all projects. Typological, technological and and dimensional classification of projects. Critical positioning of the Torino modern housing experience in a global (mainly European) panorama. Selection and discussion of comparables at European and global scale (relevant best practices & projects). Outlining of emerging trends and seminal ongoing experiences in housing, both in Torino and global.
