APPENDIX SCORE CALCULATION

1. Criteria for Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes

The score for the students enrolled in a Bachelor's or Master's degree programme is determined based on the following criteria:

- Politecnico di Torino takes into consideration only the exam credits included in the Study Plan which count towards the achievement of the degree and are validated by Politecnico di Torino;
- exams passed by the applicants but not validated are not counted (i.e., following a transfer);
- additional credits do not count towards the score (i.e., additional credits of *Percorso Intraprendenti*, Italian language credits for international students, traineeship extension credits, credits awarded following participation in special events/activities, etc.);
- in case of FULL TIME or PART-TIME enrolment for an entire academic year, the number of semesters of the career duration is set at 2;
- in case of an equal score on the ranking list, the older applicant will be chosen;
- Politecnico di Torino takes into consideration the so called "integrated courses" (*corsi integrati*) exclusively if the student has taken all modules of the course, even if not registered in the transcript yet;
- pass-or-fail exams (exams without grade) are given the value of the average grade of other exams passed by the applicant up to the present.

Please note that for all courses/activities that can be recorded in the student transcript in a period of the year other than examination sessions (i.e., traineeship, external training activities...) Politecnico di Torino takes into consideration the actual registration date; therefore, if these activities are recorded after the date indicated in Annex A, they are not considered for the score.

Students with a particularly complex university career are invited to contact the International Mobility Unit through the Ticketing Support System when they submit their application (topic "MOBILITY OUTGOING – Erasmus+ TRAINEESHIP"). Tickets sent after the deadlines for application submission will not be accepted for the calculation of the score.

2. **Score calculation - Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes**

The score is calculated by multiplying the number of credits awarded for each passed examination by the corresponding grade. For examinations that do not carry a numerical grade, the average grade of all graded examinations passed will be used. The sum of these products is then divided by the number of semesters elapsed since the applicant's first enrolment at university.

In the case of transfer from another Italian university, the number of semesters will be calculated from the applicant's first enrolment in the Italian university system, even if no previously completed examinations have been recognised towards the current Bachelor's or Master's degree programme.

For the purpose of calculating the score, a maximum of 180 CFU will be taken into account for Bachelor's degree programmes and a maximum of 120 CFU for Master's degree programmes, corresponding to the total number of credits required to obtain the respective degree.

The different methods for the application of the scoring algorithm are specified below:

1) Bachelor's students applying for ERASMUS+ Traineeship Curricular:

Each applicant is assigned a score calculated by multiplying the number of credits of each passed exam by its grade; the sum of these products is divided by the number of semesters since the first enrolment in a Bachelor's degree programme at any Italian or foreign university and then rounded up.

This calculation does not include any Master's exams that the applicant has taken while he/she was still attending the Bachelor's degree programme.

Score = sum (Bachelor's exam grade * CFU credit) / N. examination semesters

2) Master's students applying for ERASMUS+ Traineeship Curricular and Postgraduate:

Each applicant is assigned a score calculated by multiplying the number of credits of each passed exam by its grade; the sum of these products is divided by the number of semesters since the first enrolment in a Master's degree programme at any Italian or foreign university and then rounded up.

The duration of the Master's degree programme for which the applicant has advanced some Master's courses (Master's courses taken at Bachelor's level) is evaluated in semesters starting from the semester in which the applicant has added the first Master's course in his/her Annual Personal Study Plan (see art. 3.1).

Score = sum (Master's exam grade * number of credits) / N. examination semesters

3) Bachelor's and Master's students applying for ERASMUS+ Traineeship Postgraduate for which Politecnico di Torino considers exclusively the applicant's ongoing academic progress and degree attainment

Each applicant is assigned a score calculated by multiplying the weighted average grade of all the exams taken at Bachelor's/Master's level by the total number of credits required for Bachelor's/Master's graduation. This product is multiplied by the premium coefficient "K" – equal to 1.1. This coefficient refers to the credits earned by the applicants who have already earned the degree compared to the applicants who have not graduated yet. The result is divided by the number of semesters since first enrolment in the Bachelor's/Master's degree programme at any Italian/foreign university.

Score = (Bachelor's weighted average grade * 180 CFU or Master's weighted average grade * 120 CFU) * K / N. examination semesters

3 - Calculation of the Score for Complex Academic Records

3.1 Advancing Master's Degree Courses

For Master's Degree academic records that include the recognition of advance credits ("anticipi"), the number of semesters shall be calculated starting from the semester in which the first advance course was included in the student's study plan, regardless of whether the corresponding examination was actually taken or passed.

3.2 Single Courses

Where an applicant has enrolled in single courses due to not meeting the language proficiency requirement for admission to a Master's Degree programme, and one or more first-semester Master's Degree courses have been included in the study plan, the semesters of such enrolment shall be counted in the score calculation, regardless of whether the corresponding examinations were actually taken or passed.

3.3 Shortened Degree Programme Based on an Equivalent Qualification and Credit Transfer Following Withdrawal, Forfeiture, or Double Enrolment – Duration of the Academic Career

Where a student's academic career has been shortened on the basis of a previously awarded qualification at the same academic level, or where credits have been recognized following withdrawal from a programme, forfeiture, or double enrolment, examinations entered into the study plan as validated credits shall increase the number of semesters (according to the number of recognized credits), as set out in the table below.

RECOGNIZED CREDITS	ADDITIONAL SEMESTERS
1 - 30	1 semester
31 - 60	2 semesters
61 - 90	3 semesters
91 - 120	4 semesters
from 121	5 semesters

2.2 Unregistered exams

Applicants who are waiting for the registration of some exams¹ in their transcript when they submit their application must report this situation during the application phase using the online form that can be downloaded from the Call for applications website.

In the self-certificate students must indicate:

- for exams taken during the mobility project: the number of credits of the corresponding exams provided in the study plan as set out in the last approved Learning Agreement;
- for exams passed at Politecnico di Torino that have not been registered in the transcript yet: course denomination, grade and exam date.

In particular Politecnico di Torino accepts self-certificates by:

1. students who have completed a mobility project who have passed exams abroad by the dates indicated in Annex A without having yet obtained the exam validation by Politecnico by the same date. If the examinations are officially registered before the provisional ranking list is prepared, the recorded grades will be taken into account. Otherwise, the credits for examinations completed during a mobility period and declared through the self-declaration form will be assigned a grade on the Italian 30-point scale corresponding to the weighted average of the examinations officially recorded in the applicant's academic record by the deadlines specified in Annex A;

¹ exams refers to successfully completed course units, excluding Internship, other learning activities outside the university, and additional credits earned in excess of the degree requirements (as referred to in Article 1).

2. students who have completed a mobility project and have passed exams abroad by the dates indicated in Annex A and these exams have been validated by Politecnico di Torino at a later date. These examinations will be taken into account when the provisional ranking list is prepared.
3. students who have passed exams at Politecnico di Torino by the dates indicated in Annex A still waiting for the exam registration in the transcript by Politecnico by the same date.
